Please ensure your child has a water bottle each day and an ice pack in their lunch.

We were fortunate to have a health inspector into the Daycare to give a little seminar to the children on the importance of washing hands. The children really enjoyed Jacquie's presentation and we will invite her back in a few months. Thursday, March 31 at 9:00, we enjoyed a visit from the local fire department to give a lesson on fire safety. The children really enjoyed the presentation and they were able to ask many questions. <u>As the weather gets warmer, please ensure a pair of shorts or leggings are worn under dresses and skirts as we encourage pride, self-respect and privacy for all children.</u>
